Dr. Fereshte Moosavi (Iran-UK), is an independent curator and educator based in London. She has a PhD from the Curatorial/Knowledge programme at Goldsmiths University of London. Moosavi has worked for over seven years (Apr2011-Sep2018) as the art director and curator of the MOP Foundation -a non-profit organisation based in London that provides educational and representational support for Iranian artists. Moosavi is the founder of Curatorial in Other Words, a pedagogical project initiated in 2015 in collaboration with Charsoo-Honar, Tehran. She has curated a number of research-based exhibitions including; "Two-Way Street" Jan 2020, Bermondsey Project Space, London; "Dance Dance Dance" Dec 2019, Bermondsey Project Space, London; "Ali Akbar Sadeghi: A Retrospective", Tehran Museum of Contemporary Art, Jan-Mar 2018; and "Trans-Transfiguration: Sheikh Saafi's Anecdote and any Expandable Thing", Lajevardi Foundation, Tehran, May-Jul 2017.
